- Avaya Communicator for Web Single Sign-On for IP Office, Google+, Salesforce, and Office 365
- Only an Office Worker or Power User license required for Communicator for Web

4. New IP Office Contact Center features. IPOCC 9.1.6 is supported by R10.0 and offers features such as more granular metrics, greater potential for customization, more manageable reports, Avaya Contact Center Wallboard integration, and more.

5. User synchronization and LDAP integration enhancements. R10.0 builds on the user synchronization capabilities introduced by IP Office R.9.1 by offering more optional user synchronization fields (such as login code, twinned mobile number, group membership, and voicemail code), connect to directory services modifications (e.g., preserved connection settings if a test connection fails), and better LDAP job options (such as being able to modify and delete jobs from the “View Scheduled Jobs” page).
